Sir.—In the press report of the last meeting of the N.Q.H.A., appearing in your issue of the 22nd inst, Sub-editor Howard Bowen is reported as saying that the Kajabhi Hack Club remitted only £3 (three pounds) to the Chimerary Hospital as the nett proceeds of their benefit meeting held on September 11th. This is incorrect. The amount remitted was £21/11/-, verification of which may be obtained from the secretary of that institution or from the inspection of receipts in my possession. If the press is at fault he should attend to its rectification through the medium of his columns, while if his interpretation of the balance sheet (which he says he inspected) is at fault he would be more commensurate with his position if he expressed more care in his deductions before he broadcasted assertions that may only reflect on the integrity of those innocently brought within the ambit of his insinuations.—Yours &c.
