

NEVILLE STURZAKER.

After a lengthy illness, well-known Kajabbi and Cloncurry district personality, Neville Sturzaker died in the Cloncurry Hospital on Thursday afternoon at the age of 68 years. A native of Victoria, deceased came to the district in the days when Mt. Cuthbert mine was active and as a mining surveyor worked on the site. He later traded in mixed business at Mt. Cuthbert and Kajabbi and when granted a temporary license, built and opened the first hotel in Kajabbi. This building was afterwards destroyed by fire. During the time he was a publican, he contested the Flinders seat as an Independent against the then Hon.
